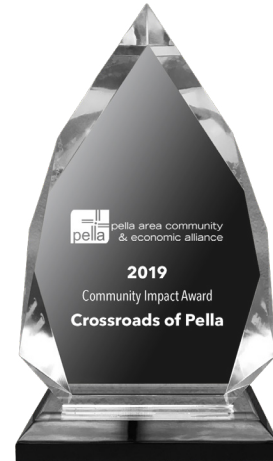

October 15th through December 7th is Medicare's Open Enrollment Period. It is the only time that individuals can change their Medicare Part D plan or Medicare Advantage plan. Be sure to check that your prescriptions will be covered in 2020, and that you aren't paying more than you should be. **DON'T WAIT!** Make your appointment with a SHIIP counselor for a comparison NOW by calling Crossroads at 641-628-1212. **PREVENTION EDUCATION:
PAM BETTGER**

As a trained Child Abuse Prevention Specialist, Pam made presentations to schools from multiple counties in our region. She spoke to **4,388 children** ranging in age from 3 years old to high school seniors, regarding appropriate touches and online safety. Each presentation included a safety plan. Additionally, **48 adults** attended various other programs which increased awareness to protect children from abuse. Thanks to generous financial support from Crossroads, United Way of Marion County, The Pella Community Foundation and direct funding from multiple schools, this program continues to thrive.

The summer of 2019 was fun and eventful! Average daily attendance was in the high 70s to low 80s. The children were separated into age groups with unique themes. Kindergarten and 1st grade were the Amazing Cupcakes, 2nd and 3rd grade were the Ultimate Cookies, and 4th grade & up were the Marvelous Marshmallows. Each group enjoyed daily activities of art, math, reading, outside play, and gym time. Field trips included trips to the pool twice a week, local parks, bowling, Blank Park Zoo, Science Center, watching Toy Story 4 at the movie theater, and many more. They also had fun playing laser tag in the gym! Sky Zone continues to be one of the favorite field trips, as we took 93 children that day.

CHRISTMAS HELP IS AVAILABLE NOW THROUGH DECEMBER 4TH

The **Adopt a Family for Christmas** program is for Pella families who are working hard but need a little extra help at Christmas. Families sign up at Crossroads. 342 people from 99 families participated in 2018. The **Marion County Toys for Tots** program is for children outside of Pella. They are referred by Marion County providers. (school counselors, nurses and social workers) 224 children received gifts in 2018. ENGLISH LANGUAGE CLASS: JANICE COOK

Crossroads offers English Language classes in our community. In the past year, **23 students attended from 7 countries**. These classes not only helped immigrants learn English, but also acclimated them into our community. Highlights from the spring included riding on the Bank Iowa float and a tour of the Pella Police Station. We enjoy getting to know our new Pella residents, and are happy to see them find a new place to call home. This fall we welcomed Janice Cook as our new instructor.
